Legislative Update # 3

February 25, 2020

Legislative Update #3 has a lot of information in it! Below are proposed bills that may be of interest to the DMHAS advocacy community. In this update I have also included information on hearing dates for several bills.

HB-5233 AN ACT CONCERNING PAYMENTS TO PROVIDERS OF SOCIAL SERVICES.

<u>SB-185</u> AN ACT EXCLUDING CERTAIN FACILITIES FROM THE DEFINITION OF COMMUNITY RESIDENCES FOR ZONING PURPOSES.

<u>SB-244</u> ACT PROHIBITING THE SALE OF CIGARETTES, TOBACCO PRODUCTS, ELECTRONIC NICOTINE DELIVERY SYSTEMS AND VAPOR PRODUCTS BY HEALTH CARE FACILITIES AND PHARMACIES.

<u>SB-247</u> S.B. No. 247 AN ACT CONCERNING MENTAL HEALTH TRAINING OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL.

<u>SB-248</u> AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESS TO IDENTITY DOCUMENTS BY HOMELESS YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULTS.

<u>HB-5206</u> (RAISED) AGING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE RENTERS' REBATE PROGRAM FOR SENIOR CITIZENS AND PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.

<u>HB-5232</u> AN ACT CONCERNING A MINIMUM BASE RATE FOR METHADONE MAINTENANCE TREATMENT.

HB-5233 AN ACT CONCERNING PAYMENTS TO PROVIDERS OF SOCIAL SERVICES.

<u>HB-5248</u> AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR PEER SUPPORT SERVICES IN THIS STATE.

HB-5254 AN ACT REQUIRING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR MEDICATIONASSISTED TREATMENT FOR OPIOID USE DISORDER.

<u>HB-5256</u> AN ACT CONCERNING REQUIRED HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR DETOXIFICATION AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES.

HB-5275 AN ACT CONCERNING A FAIR WORK WEEK SCHEDULE.

<u>SB-21</u> ACT AUTHORIZING SPORTS WAGERING, INTERNET GAMING, A CASINO GAMING FACILITY IN BRIDGEPORT, ENTERTAINMENT ZONE FACILITIES, INTERNET LOTTERY AND INTERNET KENO.

SB-193 ACT CONCERNING METHADONE MAINTENANCE.

<u>SB-212</u> ACT AUTHORIZING A CASINO GAMING FACILITY IN BRIDGEPORT, SPORTS WAGERING, ENTERTAINMENT ZONES, ONLINE GAMING, ONLINE LOTTERY TICKET SALES AND ONLINE KENO.

HB-5185 AN ACT CONCERNING TITLE PROTECTION FOR NURSES. (2/26/20, 10:30, Room 1D, LOB)

<u>SB-141</u> AN ACT DESIGNATING THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AND ADDICTION SERVICES A SINGLE HEALTH CARE ENTITY. (2/26/20, 10:30, Room 1D, LOB)

<u>SB-185</u> AN ACT EXCLUDING CERTAIN FACILITIES FROM THE DEFINITION OF COMMUNITY RESIDENCES FOR ZONING PURPOSES. (2/27/20, 12:30, Room 2A, LOB)

<u>HB-5242</u> AN ACT CONCERNING THE RISK OF HOMELESSNESS FOR THOSE RELEASED FROM THE CUSTODY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION. (2/27/20, 12:30, Room 2A, LOB)
