

Non-compliant inspection results for the month of February 2015

State Inspectors from the Department of Mental Health & Addiction Services, Tobacco Prevention & Enforcement Program conduct tobacco compliance inspections as part of an effort to stop the illegal sale of tobacco products to minors. State non-compliant inspection findings are forwarded to the Department of Revenue Services for administrative action in accordance with Connecticut General Statute §12-295a. Civil penalties start at \$300.00 for a first time offence ranging to possible suspension or revocation of the license required to sell tobacco products.
