CLINICAL PROVIDER EDUCATION ON HYPERTENSION: LEADING CLIENTS TO BETTER OUTCOMES

This class will present an overview of HTN in relation to our client population. We will explore strategies for client counseling and education to achieve positive outcomes. Participants will be provided the tools needed to recognize and refer patients for needed care related to hypertension. Staff will learn proper blood pressure monitoring techniques and its significance, leading to better patient care.

PREVENTING SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED INFECTIONS IN CLIENTS WITH MENTAL HEALTH CONDITIONS

People with mental health conditions are at an increased risk of contracting an STI. Research shows that client education and counseling promote a dramatic decrease in infection and reinfection rates. Direct care staff will be presented an overview of the most common STI's. We will discuss how to inform and counsel clients on safe sexual practices and to make appropriate referrals.
