Real ID: October 1, 2020

Is Your License Ready to Fly?

Starting October 1, 2020, the U.S. Federal Government will require anyone boarding an airplane for domestic travel or entering certain federal buildings to have a "verified" driver's license, state-issued ID card or be required to show additional proof of identification, such as a passport. This federal law is known as "REAL ID."

This verification is indicated on your license or ID card by a gold star in the top right corner.

You NEED a REAL ID if:

- You do **not** have a valid U.S. passport or passport card; AND
- You use airplanes as a mode of domestic transportation; or
- You visit military bases; or
- You visit secure federal facilities.
