### COMMISSIONER REVICZKY ATTENDS NASDA **MEETINGS AT WHITE HOUSE**

Agriculture Commissioner Steven K. Reviczky and several colleagues from the National Association of State Departments of Agriculture (NASDA) met in the nation's capital recently with the President's Special Assistant for Agriculture and the Administrator of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

The regionally diverse group of NASDA members included Louisiana Commissioner of Agriculture & Forestry and NASDA President Dr. Mike Strain, Indiana Director of Agriculture Ted McKinney, New Mexico Secretary of Agriculture Jeff Witte, and Reviczky, who currently serves as NASDA's Vice President.

"The group's meetings were focused on the need for a more vigorous partnership and role for the states in federal policymaking, and for full funding for federal mandates under which states act as co-regulators," Reviczky said.

With water quality being a critical tenet of EPA's mission, the group stressed the importance of volunteer, incentive-based nutrient management programs and the need for robust consultation and sufficient resources to assist in the maintenance and health of agriculture's most important resource.

EPA Administrator Scott Pruitt expressed his desire to work with NASDA and agricultural producers in areas of water, conservation and worker protection.

NASDA members discussed a variety of matters with Ray Starling, Special Assistant to the President (Continued on Page 3)



### SHELTON BOY WINS ANNUAL CABBAGE-GROWING CONTEST, PLANS TO JOIN FAMILY'S **FARMING TRADITION**

Sam Jones has spent his entire young life around his family's well-known Shelton farm, but he never raised his own crop until he grew a cabbage last spring as part of a national contest to spark children's interest in agriculture.

And even though last season's drought made for a little more work, the 20-pound cabbage Sam harvested earned him a \$1,000 savings bond for education when he was selected as the Connecticut winner of the 14th annual Bonnie Plants 3rd Grade Cabbage Program.

Sam was chosen from more than 7,600 third-grade students across the state who received Bonnie cabbage plants to take home, nurture, and grow.

He received his prize earlier this month during an assembly at his school, Mohegan Elementary in Shel-

"He was thrilled," said his mother, Christiana. "Sam wants to be a farmer when he grows up and will use the scholarship to learn more about farming."

Sam is part of the 7th generation at Jones Family Farms, where he grew up learning about farming from his father Jamie, grandfather Terry and greatgrandfather Philip.

"Although he is surrounded by farming and growing plants, he took particular interest in growing the cabbage because it was his own crop," said Christiana,

who helps manage the farm.

Sam planted the 2-inch cabbage seedling – one of more than 1.5 million supplied by Bonnie to students across the country - in a small garden bed next to his family's driveway.

During frosty spring nights he had to remember to cover it, his mother said, and to uncover it when the sun was out in full force.

Last season's drought also required Sam to keep on the ball with watering.

"When he harvested it in early June, Sam was happy to see his cabbage was over 20 pounds!," Christiana said.

Sam, who will turn 10 this week, also decided to donate 10 percent of his award to the CT Agricultural Experiment Station because, as Christiana quoted her son: "Their scientists expand our knowledge of plants and help other farmers."

More than 1.5 million students took part in the Bonnie Plants program last year.

Teachers from each participating class select the student who has grown the best cabbage, based on size and appearance

That student's name is then entered in a statewide drawing, and state winners are randomly selected by the head agriculture official in each of the 48 participating

"This program is a great way to expose young students to farming and agriculture and I encourage every elementary school in Connecticut to consider participating," said Commissioner Steven K. Reviczky, who (above right) helped present Sam with his award at the school assembly.
