Effective July 1, 2013, as a result of recently passed legislation, the following changes are being implemented by the Board of Pardons and Paroles.

- Risk Reduction Earned Credit will no longer be applied to the eligibility dates of offenders designated 85%. There has been no change to Risk Reduction Earned Credit as it applies to 50% eligibility.
- The Board of Pardons and Paroles is no longer required to hold a parole hearing for all parole eligible inmates.
- As a result of these changes, the Board of Pardons and Paroles has the discretion to decide whether or not you will be afforded a parole hearing to be considered for parole. If it is determined that you will not have a parole hearing, you will be notified in writing as to the specific reason or reasons why. This applies to all cases regardless of 50% or 85% designation.

Parole Management and Officers will be touring institutions in the coming weeks to provide clarification regarding the new process.
