The historic Ponemah Mills site dates back to the 1860's and was once a thriving textile mill based in the Taftville section of Norwich.

Before this site was thought to be developed into a brand new mixed-income, affordable housing development, the mill stood abandoned and unused for several years.

This project marks a massive collaboration across state government and with private sector investors; leveraging not only state and federal resources but also contributions from the developer.
