
Sexual Violence in the State of Connecticut



77% OF VICTIMS IN CONNECTICUT KNOW THEIR PERPETRATORS

2x more likely to experience **poor physical health** over 2x more likely to experience **poor mental health**

*sexual assault, stalking or intimate partner violence

7.8% of CT students in grades 9-12 reported being forced to have sexual intercourse.

Connecticut students who experienced sexual violence* were:

3x more likely to use prescription and over-the-counter **drugs** to get high **2x more likely** to feel **sad or hopeless** almost every day for a period of 2+ weeks **3x more likely** to **miss school** because they felt unsafe 2.7x more likely to self-harm during the previous year

*in their dating relationships



2x more likely to seriously consider attempting suicide **2x more likely** to **experience bullying** at school and online
