Why You Are Receiving This Letter

Connecticut Department of Revenue Services (DRS) records show that you filed a 2016 Connecticut Income Tax return, but have not yet filed a 2017 return. We are notifying you so that you may avoid the accumulation of interest and non-filer penalties.

- Review your Connecticut state income tax filing records. If necessary, contact your tax preparer.
