Congratulations! This year 77% of our Agencies, Offices, Commissions and Quasi-Public Agencies achieved 100% timely compliance. Forty-two agencies or 70% of those agencies earned the distinction of not only achieving 100% timely compliance but also had 100% submit filings electronically. There are 2,552 SFI filers and 99% met the May 1 deadline. Of those, 98% filed electronically.
