## **DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT**

On August 20, 2009, the Office of State Ethics received a complaint naming Peter Agnesi as the Respondent in an alleged violation of the Code of Ethics for Public Officials. Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §1-82(a), the Office of State Ethics conducted a preliminary investigation to determine whether there was probable cause to believe that the Respondent violated provisions of the Code of Ethics for Public Officials as alleged in the complaint.

The investigation concluded that there are insufficient facts that would support a finding of probable cause if this matter were to proceed to a probable cause hearing.

The public complaint is hereby dismissed and our file is now closed. Pursuant to General Statutes §1-82a, this matter shall remain confidential, unless you request otherwise in writing.
