
The above captioned matter was heard as a contested case on May 10, 1976, at which time the complainant and the respondents appeared and presented testimony and exhibits on the complaint.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above captioned complaint:


1. The complaint is hereby withdrawn pursuant to the stipulation of the parties hereto as described above.
