
The above-captioned matter was scheduled to be heard as a contested case on January 11, 2018 at 2:30 P.M, at which time Captain Jeff Golden appeared on behalf of the respondents, but the complainant did not appear to prosecute the case.

The hearing officer notes that Captain Golden represented that, prior to the scheduled hearing, the respondents spent considerable time gathering and assembling the records responsive to the complainant's request. Captain Golden further represented that, once the records were assembled, the respondents notified the complainant of such fact; however, the complainant never picked up the records or otherwise contacted the respondents.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. The complaint is hereby dismissed.
2. The complainant is admonished for his failure to appear at the hearing in this matter, which failure resulted in a waste of scarce local and state resources.
