Following a preliminary introduction of the case and review of the hearing procedures on the record, the parties agreed to go off the record to see if they could stipulate to documents as evidence. While off the record, the parties held a settlement conference without the presence of the hearing officer. After the settlement conference, the complainant and the respondents requested that the hearing be continued, which was granted.

Subsequently, by facsimile dated March 14, 2019, the complainant withdrew his complaint in Docket# FIC 2018-0726. The Commission takes administrative notice of such withdrawal.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. Based on the withdrawal of the complaint, the case is hereby dismissed.
