By email, dated January 23, 2019, the complainant informed the Commission that he wished to withdraw his complaint in this matter. The Commission takes administrative notice of such withdrawal.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. The complaint is dismissed.
