Department of Developmental Services Siobhan Morgan

- **ICM-** Integrated Care Model- DDS had participated in the development of the Dual Eligibles initiative in 2015- this initiative was not funded so the efforts halted last spring.
- **Behavioral Health Home** (DMHAS)-we do not participate in this directly but we may have individuals and families that benefit through the coordinated approach with DMHAS and DCF.
- Intensive case management is operated by Community Health Network of CT the Administrative Service Organization(ASO) is a service offered under Medicaid it can target certain populations- we have collaborated with them regarding training and outreach to the Medicaid population and providers. We share data with them weekly and we assist on outreach to our staff and Individuals/families.

LTSS rebalancing-

MFP- DDS has moved over 200 people from institutional settings- we partner in Nursing Home Closures,

CFC- we participated in the development, roll-out and are actively engaged in assisting families access this Medicaid benefit,

No Wrong Door - development of MyPlaceCT website and ongoing work that has just resumed after a short hiatus,

Universal Assessment - participate in development, implementation, training and outreach- extensive involvement in the development with DSS IT partners

Housing partnership- collaboration with Housing, OPM and DSS on the CMS Innovation Accelerator Program on Medicaid-Housing Partnerships

ASO (Administrative Service Organization)- we collaborate primarily with:
Community Health Network of CT- we have streamlined a process regarding authorizations specific to DDS waiver participants,
Beacon Health - ongoing partnership regarding ASD State Plan services and collaboration of member and waiver services
Dental- We have a close relationship with the Connecticut Dental Health Partnership (CDHP) who administer Medicaid for CT. They

have a Dental Health Care Specialist who works closely with individuals, families, case mangers on difficult cases to expedite treatment. We collaborate to with DSS to maintain coverage, aiding in lapsed coverage. Individuals with intellectual disabilities and medically compromised individuals receive more comprehensive coverage, such as 2 dental prophylaxis a year. Izabella is on several committees, but non that involve Medicaid directly.

Logisticare (Medical Transportation)-

• **TEFT-** Testing Experience and Functional Tools (TEFT) CT was awarded the grant by CMS. CT is participating in all four areas. Testing Experience and Functional Tools (TEFT)- is designed to field test a cross-disability participant experience and testing a functional assessment, create/demonstrate personal and electronic health records to standardize across all LTSS services. DDS is not currently testing but we are part of the CT review of the tool and evaluating the benefit to CT DSS with UConn is the lead on this.
