Driver's license with (Class M) motorcycle endorsement

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF COURSE:

This is a 12-day, Northwestern University certification course to facilitate the safe & efficient operation of a police motorcycle for; patrol, traffic enforcement, escorts & other police related functions.

Upon successfully completing this school, the student will be proficient in:

- 1. Knowledge of Police Motorcycle Controls
- 2. Conducting pre-ride inspection of motorcycle
- 3. Basic & safe riding skills / habits
- 4. Police riding formations & signals
- 5. Fundamentals of Traffic Stops w/ a Police Motorcycle
- 6. Police Motorcycle Escorts
- 7. Handling a Police Motorcycle at slow speeds in cone pattern exercises
- 8. Performing evasive maneuvers
- 9. Surmounting obstacles
- 10. Adjusting to special riding situations
- 11. Proper & safe braking techniques
