1. Verification Procedures

By November 15 of each year, local educational agencies (LEAs) must complete verification of a sample of their approved free and reduced-price meal applications. The verification sample is obtained from new meal applications on file as of the first operating day in October. LEAs must do Standard Sample Size Verification (selecting applications that are error prone) unless they had a nonresponse rate of less than 20 percent in the prior school year. For more information, refer to the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Eligibility Manual for School Meals (dated July 18, 2017), and the following resources from the Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE):

The USDA's *Strategies to Improve Response Rates in the Verification Process* provides an overview of practices used by school food authorities around the country to encourage households to respond to the verification process.

2. Rolling Verification

The USDA recently provided guidance on conducting Rolling Verification. This verification process allows LEAs to start verification earlier in the school year to help improve the household response rate and save time by decreasing the administrative burden, especially for LEAs that must verify large numbers of applications. The USDA developed the following tools to assist LEAs with the Rolling Verification process:

- Verification Toolkit; and
- Rolling Verification webinar.

If a LEA is considering Rolling Verification, it is essential that the verifying official reviews the Rolling Verification Webinar and Toolkit prior to implementation.

3. Verification Collection Report

This report is due to the CSDE no later than **December 15, 2018**. It must be completed in the Connecticut Online Application and Claiming System for Child Nutrition Programs (CNP System), as shown below.
