CT Technical High Schools—Task Force Update

(HARTFORD, CONN.) An October 13, 2011 press release from the Connecticut Department of Education indicated the 2011 session of the General Assembly passed legislation creating a CT Technical High Schools (CTHSS) Task Force to study the finance, management and enrollment structure of the regional vocational–technical schools system.

The first meeting of the task force was conducted September 27th and three additional meetings were scheduled through December 1st.

The November 10th meeting has been rescheduled to Thursday, November 17th. Please review the updated list of meetings:

The meeting will focus on the costs and benefits of maintaining the Adult Education programs at the technical high schools.

Thursday, December 1, 2011-10am-12pm at A.I. Price Technical High School, Hartford, CT

The meeting will focus on strengthening articulation agreements with the community-technical colleges.

CTHSS Task Force Public Hearing

The CTHSS Task Force will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, December 13, 2011 from 5pm-8pm in room 1E at the Legislative Office Building, Hartford, CT. Anyone with an interest in the technical high school system is invited to attend. State officials and several constituent groups will also be invited to attend and testify. The CTHSS Task Force website will be updated as more details become available.
