#### FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

### **ISSUES:**

- 1. Whether the Student was inappropriately exited from eligibility for special education and discontinued services.
- 2. Whether the Student is eligible for special education and shall continue to receive special education and related services.

#### **SUMMARY:**

The Board received this request for hearing on October 3, and a prehearing conference was held on October 16. The case proceeded with testimony on three hearing dates on December 2, 4 and 11 with testimony from six witnesses. On December 18, the fourth hearing date, the both parties reported on the record that the case had settled.

The matter is **DISMISSED**, with prejudice.
