FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Board has failed to provide FAPE to the Student;
2. Whether the Board should pay for the Student's placement at Ben Bronz Academy for Spring 2010, Summer 2010, and the 2010-2011 school year.

SUMMARY:

On May 20, 2010, the Board received the Request for Due Process. A Prehearing Conference was held on June 1, 2010 and hearing dates were scheduled. On July 12, 2010, Counsel for the Parent withdrew the Due Process Request and requested that the matter be dismissed with prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
