FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Board failed to offer FAPE for the 2010-2011 school year;
2. Whether the Student should be placed in a private day program;
3. Whether the Student should be placed at Villa Maria at the Board's expense;
4. Whether the Board should pay for the Student's private speech and language services, occupational therapy, and physical therapy.

SUMMARY:

On August 11, 2010, the Board received the Request for Due Process. On August 31, 2010, a Prehearing Conference was held and hearing dates were scheduled. On September 26, 2010, pursuant to a Motion by the Parents, the deadline to mail the Final Decision and Order was extended to November 24, 2010. On October 28, 2010, Counsel for the Parent withdrew the Request for Due Process.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED without prejudice.**
