FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Did the Board offer appropriate programs for the 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 school years?
2. Did the Board offer an appropriate program for the 2018-2019 school year?
3. If the answer to #2 is in the negative, does Student require an out of district placement?
4. If the answer to #1 above is in the negative, do the circumstances warrant an award of compensatory education?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed a Hearing Request on July 30, 2018. The Hearing Officer was appointed on July 31, 2018 and conducted a Prehearing Conference on August 13, 2018, during which the Parent was granted leave to amend the Hearing Request. The hearing was scheduled for October 23, 2018. On October 12, 2018, the Parent's attorney withdrew the Due Process Complaint without prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
