Alternatively, if Head Moderator faxes the preliminary report, as described above, Head Moderator can send a complete signed set of returns by mail to Secretary of the State to be received by the Friday after the election. If late, the moderator must pay a late fee of \$50.
- 3. Head Moderator must deliver the other complete signed set of these returns to the Town Clerk on or before the day after the election.
