Important Notes:

- Public Act No. 05-153 became effective July 1, 2005. Both the Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) and the transmittal must be received no later than the fifth business day of the following month. For example, the EFT due date for the September 2008 deductions is October 7, 2008. The interest charge of 9% per year will be applied if either the members' contributions or the transmittal is not submitted by the due date.
- Make sure that the three digit town code (without the number sign) on your EFT transmission to our bank is the same three digit town number you are using on your end of month transmittal.
- The EFT need only be a single dollar amount transferred from your bank to our bank. It is not necessary to allocate your deposit by Regular, Health Fund, Voluntary and Service Contract payments. This allocation will be determined when you send your monthly transmittal to us at the end of each month.
- There is no provision in the current statute that would permit any Teachers' Retirement Board staff member to waive any interest assessment that has been levied due to a late deposit of the mandatory contributions or a late submission of the transmittal file.
