Important Notes:

- Teachers' Retirement Board (TRB) must receive both the EFT and the transmittal no later than the fifth business day of the following month. For example, the due date for the September 2009 deductions and transmittal is October 7, 2009. An interest charge of 9% per year will be applied if TRB does not receive either the members' contributions or the transmittal by the due date.
- Make sure that the three digit town code (without the number sign) on your EFT transmission to our bank is the same three digit town number you are using on your transmittal.
- The EFT need only be a single dollar amount transferred from your bank to our bank. It is not necessary to allocate your deposit by Regular, Health Fund, Voluntary and Service Contract payments. The transmittal will determine this allocation.
