

MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL POLICY 97-06

Subject: Increase in Family Sick Leave for Management and Confidential Employees from Three (3) to Five (5) Days per Calendar Year

Date: November 18, 1997

In accordance with Section 5-200 (p) of the Connecticut General Statutes, the Commissioner of Administrative Services with the approval of the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management approves the increase of family sick leave for eligible managerial and confidential employees from three (3) days per year to five (5). Family sick leave shall be granted in the event of critical illness or severe injury to a member of the immediate family creating an emergency. Immediate family means husband, wife, father, mother, sister, brother or child, and also any relative who is domiciled in the employee's household.

The sick leave is being extended to managerial and confidential employees as it has been to a majority of contractual bargaining unit employees. This Item supersedes Regulation 5-247-4 (3).
