NEW BILLS OF INTEREST

[S.B. No. 1040](#) (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE REGISTRATION OF JUVENILES AS SEXUAL OFFENDERS AND NOTIFICATION OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS THAT A REGISTRANT MAY BE A STUDENT IN THE DISTRICT', to require sexual offenders, regardless of their age, to register as sexual offenders and to require that local and regional boards of education receive notice of any potential student who may be a registrant. [S.B. No. 1042](#) (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS FOR THE PROSECUTION OF SEXUAL ASSAULT', to extend the statute of limitations for prosecuting sexual assault. REF. JUDICIARY
