I am pleased to submit this report as required by Section 17a-100c of the General Statutes concerning actual or suspected instances of animal neglect or cruelty.

Between January 1, 2015, and December 31, 2015, The Department of Children and Families has received a total of eighty-seven (87) written reports from the Department of Agriculture during calendar year 2015. Of the eighty-seven (87) reports received, thirty-eight (38) had histories with DCF; however, eight (8) met the standard for an investigation by DCF based on the information in the written report and it was accepted.

In addition, I'm attaching a de-identified summary of the reports received, by month, for your review.
